Position Overview

- Assist in data collection and development in Collections

- Construct storage mounts and shelves
- Other responsibilities as assigned

Unpaid interns and research assistants will be accepted throughout the year on a rolling application schedule. Applications need to be received at least a month before the proposed start date.

Please note that materials submitted in your application packet will not be returned. The number and frequency of internships available varies. A department may be unable to offer an internship for a particular semester, for varying reasons, even after an opening has been posted. You will be notified if your chosen department is not able to offer an internship.

Note that before beginning, each intern will need to pass a criminal background check.

TIME REQUIREMENTS

Interns must be available to work a minimum of 7 hours per week with flexible schedules within set hours.

ACADEMIC CREDIT

Some colleges give credit for internships. Students are responsible for arranging with their schools to receive credit. Internships are unpaid.
